## **QUESTION ONE**

### **From Mr Cosgrove to the Chair of the Economy Committee, Councillor Cooper**

Decision of the Council in March 2021 to establish a Working Party to consider presentations made to Councillors in February 2021 re Bognor Regis Regeneration: Why has the Council failed to convene this in contravention of its own decision, and when is it expected that it will be convened?

### **Response**

As you have previously been advised the LUF project has effectively overtaken events as it relates to the Regis Centre area.

In addition, since the agreement in March 2021, the Council has moved to the Committee system and is taking this through that structure which therefore has continuous reports and dialogue with Councillors around the LUF bid.
