
Dogs in open spaces and on beaches – time to have your say

4. Place St Maur in Bognor Regis was refurbished last year and is now a busy open space with water fountains which are popular for children's play. The area also hosts events. Whilst it is not a formal play area in the traditional sense, it is proposed that a dogs on leads requirement is formalised here all year round for the protection of users.



5. There are several existing restrictions within Hotham Park and it is proposed to extend dogs on leads to the discovery garden which is primarily used for environmental and or outdoor education purposes.



6. There are increasing issues with dog fouling along the West Beach board walk. The boardwalk runs through the Site of Special Scientific Interest and a Nature Reserve. Many people let their dog out of the car from the Rope Walk car park, therefore it is proposed that the area leading to the boardwalk by the toilets to be dogs on leads.
