**Mandatory conditions**

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence or (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

3. (1) the responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) in this paragraph an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises,

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to;

(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol),

or (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise)

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

(d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

(e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).

4. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

5. (1) the premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol. (2) the designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licences must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) the policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:-

(a) a holographic mark

or (b) an ultraviolet feature.

6. The responsible person shall ensure that –

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures

(i) beer or cider 12 pint: (ii) gin rum vodka or whisky 25 ml or 35 ml: and (iii) still wine in a glass 125 ml: and

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises: and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available. Minimum drinks pricing<sup>1</sup>. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.<sup>2</sup> For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 -(a) 'duty' is to be construed in accordance with the alcoholic liquor duties act 1979 (b) 'permitted price' is the price found by applying the formula  $p = d + (dxv)$  where -(i) p is the permitted price (ii) d is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and (iii) v is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol:

(c) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence; (i) the holder of the premises licence (ii) the designated premises supervisor if any in respect of such a licence, or (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

(d) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question;

and (e) 'value added tax' means, value added tax charged in accordance with the value added tax act 1994.

3. Where the permitted price given by paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from the paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.<sup>4</sup> (1) sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ('the first day') would be different from the permitted price on the next day ('the second day') as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax. (2) the permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

### **Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

1. Dancing throughout premises for pub customers during play of recorded/live music.
2. All performances will finish at least half hour before the supply of alcohol finish time.
3. Regulated music activities held outside to cease at 23.30 hours on Friday and Saturday.
4. Any condition or restriction referring to Licensable Activities outside includes the marquee All outside Licensable Activities to encompass a marquee erected for the period 01 April to 31 October annually, for pre booked functions only.
5. Providing a 30 minute extension of opening hours after the end of the supply of alcohol will Not less than 5 working days written notice will be provided to police when events days are planned. Regular liaison with police. Proof of age verification to be used. Zero policy on the supply or use of drugs.  
(Annual Corgi testing on appliances and PAT as required). Fire exits kept clear.
6. Regulated music activities held outside to cease at 23.30 hours on Friday and Saturday. All regulated entertainment will end before we cease to supply alcohol - see operating schedule.
7. All performances will finish at least half hour before the end time of alcohol
8. Regulated music activities held outside to cease at 23.30 hours on Friday and Saturday.
9. Regular noise checks during performances or regulated entertainment and appropriate action taken.

- Customer notices re leaving the premises quietly.
- Outside areas kept clean and tidy. Bins emptied regularly. No drinks taken off site apart from off-sales.
- Regulated entertainment activities held outside to cease at 23.30 hours Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- The sale, supply of alcohol conducted outside to cease at 23.30 hours The provision of late night refreshment outside to cease at 00.00 hours Noise Management plan in place for the occasional, and seasonal only, use of a marquee in the gardens of the Fox Inn for pre booked functions and wedding receptions.
- Proof of age system operated.
- Children under the age of 16 years will not be permitted on the premises after 23.00 hours unless attending a pre booked private function and accompanied by an adult..
- The provision of late night refreshment in the marquee to cease at 00.00 hours.

**Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

1. the Designated Premises Supervisor be removed;
2. the conditions of the licence be modified as proposed by Environmental Health, as follows:

i. No live or recorded music or amplified speech shall take place in the marquee or other outside areas until an independent acoustic report has been submitted to and agreed in writing with Arun District Council's Environmental Health Team and the mitigation measures detailed in the acoustic report have been fully implemented.

The acoustic report must include:

Reference to BS 8223:2014 Table 2; the noise transmission paths from the marquee;

1. the breakout of noise from the marquee via the door(s);
2. details of the amplification system and speakers;
3. noise insulation measures to be installed in the marquee to prevent noise transmission;
4. specific details of the siting of the marquee, including minimum distances from bound
5. details of an in-line noise limiter to be installed in the premises which will automatically cut out once the agreed noise level is exceeded;
6. before first use of the noise limiter, the system shall be set with a tamper proof seal in the presence of an officer of the Council.
7. The noise limiter shall be serviced regularly.
8. A log shall be kept of times when it is tripped, reason for trip and corrective action taken. Records shall be kept for a year.
9. The records must be available at the premises when the premises is open to the public.
10. The noise limiter shall be installed using a dedicated tamper proof socket or be wired in directly.
11. Once operational the site (and any visiting DJs/bands/musicians) shall only use the amplification system that forms part of the acoustic report and no other.
12. Use of the system will cease by 22.00hrs each day or 21.30hrs on Sundays and bank holidays.
13. Amplified music and any amplified voices in outdoor areas (including a marquee) shall only take place during the following hours:  
12.00 - 22.00hrs Monday to Saturday  
12.00 - 21.30hrs on Sundays and bank holidays.
14. No live or recorded music shall take place at the premises until a Noise Management Plan has been submitted in writing to, and been agreed in writing by, Arun District Council's Environmental Health Team. Once agreed it shall be fully implemented thereafter.
15. The Noise Management Plan shall include:
  - supervision and management of the noise limiter
  - control of patron noise outside
  - procedure for dealing with complaints of noise and corrective action taken procedure for proactive monitoring.

16. The details of all the locations, directions and sizes of the speakers on the premises must be submitted in writing for written approval by Arun District Council's Environmental Health Team, no speakers will be permitted outside other than those forming part of the approved system.

17. alterations to the location, direction or type of speaker shall occur, until written approval has been submitted and agreed by Arun District Council's Environmental Health Team.

18. A Designated Premises Supervisor or nominated representative shall be on the premises at all times the premises is open to the public to ensure conditions 1-5 are complied with and to take action to resolve any non-compliances with conditions 1-6 If there is no personal licence holder at the premises then no music or amplified speech shall be played in the premises.
