Subject: The Fox Inn Patching - Failure to Comply with an Enforcement Notice court

Dear Joanne and Louise,

Just a quick email to update you regarding the court enforcement case for The Fox Inn,
Arundel Road, Patching.

The case of failing to comply with an Enforcement Notice was held at Crawley
Magistrates Court this morning in respect of the above matter. Neither Mr Boxhall nor
Ms Murphy were in attendance and they had not made any contact with the court.

An application to prove the matter in their absence which was granted.

The facts of the matter were set out and attention drawn for the bench to the
photographs of the breach as contained within the exhibits. The magistrates found the
case proved accordingly.

The Prosecution Solicitor outlined the sentencing powers, and after consideration, each
defendant was ordered to pay a fine of £1,100, costs of £658 and victim surcharge of
£440 resulting in a total liability for the offence of £4,396.
