Justification for need to waive Standing Orders Relating to Contracts: The reasons for the waiver must explain why it is not possible or appropriate to follow standing orders. e.g. a delay until the next signing date for the Cabinet Member or meeting of the Cabinet and waiting for the call-in period to expire, would not be in the interests of the Council because xxx.	<ul> <li>The Council is awarding this contract on the basis of extreme urgency brought about by the Covid-19 outbreak in accordance with Regulation 32(2)(c) of the Public Contract Regulations 2015. The Council is satisfied that the requirements of this provision are met as follows:</li> <li>1. Genuine reason for extreme urgency – The rapid spread and significant impact of COVID-19 is unprecedented on a global scale and the impact on Arun residents is immediate. Furthermore, the Council was directed with extreme short notice by Central Government to ensure all homeless individuals were provided with accommodation to assist in preventing the spread of Covid-19.</li> <li>2. Events leading up to the need for extreme urgency are unforeseeable - The unprecedented nature of this crisis is such that it is impossible to foresee what will happen even on a day to day basis. Furthermore, it is not possible to make realistic predictions based on the experiences of other European countries as these are also evolving and changing on a daily basis.</li> <li>3. It is impossible to comply with the usual timescales and procurement routes – the Council was provided with only days' notice by Central Government of the requirement to secure accommodation for homeless individuals. The Council would not have been able to meet this requirement had a full tender process been undertaken.</li> <li>4. The situation is not attributable to the Council - COVID-19 emerged and spread from China. The Council has not done anything which may be said to have contributed to its spread.</li> </ul>

Justification that a delay until the next meeting of the Cabinet would not be in the interests of the Council:	Permission is further sought on the same basis to waive the normal decision making process set out at Contract Standing Orders paragraph 5.2 in relation to this contract and permit additional 3 week periods to be agreed with the supplier by way of officer's decisions. This is necessary to ensure the Council is able to continue to be flexible and agile in its response to the Covid-19 outbreak and the needs of homeless individuals.
