The application is being submitted due to investment in the premises to alter the premises layout, refurbish the internals and to provide a higher quality & extended rear external area. The installation of an additional bar servery in the rear external area which shall alleviate congestion on the main bar servery to reduce customer waiting times and provide full time monitoring of the rear external area.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- Staff shall receive training in the Challenge 25 policy, Underage sales prevention and completion and maintenance of the refusals log and the incident log upon the commencement of their employment. This training shall be documented and refreshed at no greater than 12-monthly intervals
- An incident log shall be maintained at the premises and record:
 - a) All crimes reported to the venue
 - b) All ejections from the venue
 - c) Any complaints received to the venue
 - d) Any incidents of disorder
 - e) Any seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - f) Any refusal of sales of alcohol
 - g) Any visit by responsible authorities
- 3. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. All entry

and exit points will be covered enabling clear frontal identification of every person entering. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises are open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the entire 31 days period.

- A minimum of 2 SIA registered Door Supervisors will be employed every Friday & Saturday from 21:00 until close, or on any other day of the week when the sale of alcohol takes place after midnight and the premises remain open after 00:30.
- Where SIA registered door supervisors are used at the premises, a record must be kept of their SIA registration number, their name and the dates and times they are on duty

c) Public safety

We understand our obligations under existing legislation and take our responsibilities seriously

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Doors and windows to the premises will be kept closed, so far as practicable, at all times when noise generating regulated entertainment is taking place i.e. live and recorded music
- Notices shall be prominently displayed at all public exits requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and area quietly.

e) The protection of children from harm

- A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS hologram.

Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance

on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
