Background Paper 3: CIL Spending Flowcharts

Example 2: Application received for two projects, listed on the approved Arun Infrastructure Investment Plan 2022-2025 (IIP) at one time (one project is coming forward sooner than planned in the IIP), therefore, insufficient CIL to spend on both projects

Application form received requesting CIL Money from April 2022 onwards.

Application made using proforma available on ADC website, but it is for a project which has come forward a year earlier than expected in the IIP.

At the same time an application, which aligns with the IIP is received. There is insufficient CIL available for both projects in that year. Ask the following questions:

Is the application for a project listed on the approved Arun IIP 2022-2025?

YES

Do the details of the request for CIL money, match the details set out in the approved Arun IIP 2022-2025?

NO – the scheme is coming forward sooner than planned in the IIP, and there is insufficient funding available to pass CIL over to this project as well as the scheduled project

The request will be refused and applicant advised to wait until the year that the IIP has allowed for that scheme to be funded.

N.B. This situation should not occur due to the level of consultation and engagement involved in the preparation of the IIP. However, if this situation occurs more than once in an IIP period, this will trigger a review of the Arun IIP.

YES

- Providing full details and supporting evidence in application proforma; and
- Legal services drawing up final contract (master contract plus proforma)
