Thank you for your letter (Ref NL/sjz) dated 12 February 2019.

Could I please ask that, in your current review of fees, you take account of the fact that the 'cost recover' for Arundel Farmers Market cannot possibly be as much as £1,850.

As I said in my letter of 28 January, the only costs which would seem to incurred by the Council in relation to Arundel Farmers Market are:

- The annual renewal of the Street Trading Consent (for which we provide a digital List of Traders in the format required by ADC, in order to reduce the ADC workload); and
- Once every year or two, an Environmental Health inspection of Market Traders on a Saturday morning.

I would not have thought that the Council costs involved in this could possibly exceed £500 per annum.

I would be grateful if you could also bring this matter to the attention of the Licensing Committee.
